The format will be a series of short questions that will be based on the Juz (part) being recited that day during Taraweeh prayers. So in order for you to be able to correctly answer the questions you will have to familiarize yourselves with that particular Juz. Don't count on Sheikh Google or Imam Wikipedia!

Ramadan Competition Information and Rules

1. Brothers and Sisters are both eligible for participation in the Ramadan competition.
2. To participate, please send your full name and email address to anasir@purdue.edu. An email with the website link will be sent to you every day when a new question is posted. You may also visit the ISGL website to get the link for that day. Just follow the link to enter your answers.
3. Ensure your responses are free from spelling mistakes and grammatical errors. Points will not be awarded if responses are not legible.
4. Questions will be emailed to participants after 'Asr prayers and are due by midnight that day.
5. The first person to provide the correct answer will be considered the winner for that day. Correct answers are worth 1 point and the person with the most number of points by the end of Ramadan will be the winner. The correct answers will be provided the next day.
6. There will be 3 winners. 1st place will receive \$200, 2nd place will receive \$125 and the 3rd place will receive \$75.
